Chase Drive Connection	Construct bike trail connection to Chase Drive adjacent to Hagen Park. Coordinate project with Cordova Park District.	\$117,000
PCA Bridge – Erosion Improvements	Project to include installation of erosion control materials along the banks of the trail to help alleviate scouring of the trail sides and bank erosion. (To be done by Department of Transportation Staff)	\$130,000
Mile 18 Shoulder Improvements	Plans are to widen shoulders in this area at two locations, work to consist of grading shoulders back at 3:1.	\$5,000
Mile 16 Trail and Slope Repair	Construct bike trail shoulder and embankment repairs; embankment repair to consist of dry stack boulder retaining structure and DG sloped egress. Will require survey; may require cultural resources study and consultation with Native American Tribe.	\$137,000
Mile 20.5 Raise Bike Trail	Install 68' of 8' AC path with 3' DG shoulders Note: project revised to accommodate short term detours.	\$21,000
Cordova Creek Prefab concrete bridge at mile 15.3	Install new bridge foundation (piles) Note: This project is pending revision and cost may increase due to a trail/bridge realignment	\$105,200
ARBT Sign Reparations	Install new traffic and way finding signs and replacement of old signs as necessary.	\$25,000
ARBT Paint Striping Project	Restriping approx. 18.4 miles of ARBT with paint. This portion of the ARBT currently has painted centerline striping.	\$30,000
Bridge Inspections	Conduct bridge safety inspections on a 3 or 5 year basis.	\$40,000
