- **Parkway Watch Reports -25 reports**

- At Sutter's Landing Park where we witnessed no less than a dozen off-leash dogs and several people drinking alcohol at the river. A very large, (over 100 year old), oak tree has fallen across the foot path between Bannister Park and the Sunrise foot bridge.
- The star thistle is encroaching on the kayak launching trail at Sutter's Landing Park so badly that it's hard to get down the trail.
- There is a bold illegal camp right next to the main trail (kayak launching trail) heading down to the river at Sutter's Landing Park
- A young couple is camping in a cave on the river bluff beneath the Riverwood development
- There was what appeared to be a homeless camp on an island on the American River that is parallel to the levy along Rio High School
- Illegal camp site. A brown tent setup deep in wooded area east of Rossmoor Bar Rd. parking lot.
- Fire hazard due to wetland preserve area on kingsbridge not being mowed - leaving dry tall grass on edges of walkway near homes
- Car battery on side of bike trail. North side of Lake Natoma
- Illegal camp - The cottonwood grove on east side of the parking lot at Rossmoor Bar parking lot
- Water hyacinth is chocking both sides of the dock at Hogback
- Many illegal camps along equestrian trail and river bank around mile 4 of the Sacramento River Parkway
- Tree limb down at the 9.5 mile marker, horse trail. Made it difficult to pass
- Motorcycles on main bike trail, Dry Creek Parkway. Equestrian Trail Patrol's to talk to them but they had ran off

- Illegal camp sites near the west side of the mitigation area in Riverbend near mm15
- Many off leash dogs on all of the horse trail at Sailor Bar. Couple of bikes on trail, too
- Trash, diaper, shoes, food and feces along the banks of the boat dock – Howe Access
- Illegal camp - The camp is located at Sutters Landing near the banks of the river and besides what is officially called the "boat launch path."
- The Sacramento Northern Bike trail has glass that hasn't been removed for several weeks
- Illegal Camp site. Two brown tents and gear set up just off horse trail north of Rossmoor Bar tree plantation
- At approximately 3 am our dog woke us up. Looking outside there was a car moving slowly upon turning the outside light on the car moved away quickly
- Animal Cruelty - Man riding on a bike with dog on a leash. Dog is along side or trailing slight behind the bike breathing all the dust this Bozo's bike is kicking up. Ambassador entrance
- An active illegal camp, previously reported, still has multiple occupants and a big mess on Mile 6N of the American River Parkway.
- Remnants of a large camp under Bus. 80 freeway on south side of American River at mile 4.
- The overgrowth of plant life at the boat dock made it unusable for us to launch our jet ski. Hogback
- 3 Illegal camps and a rope swing on Parkway mile 6N
- My issue is that you provide two Handicap spaces and no other vehicle parking during the summer. You claim that it's a walk in park, but the county has placed "No Parking" signs throughout the whole neighborhood. This is reverse discrimination!
